FOLLOWING THE SERVICE THE MASTER HIRES A CARMAN'S CART

The Master's 1898 GOVERNESS CART



Every year on Installation Day, Carmen recall their origins, practice and purpose – the service of carriage of goods for public benefit – and the Master hires a cart for a fee of five shillings. This ceremony remembers the hiring of carts from Carrooms or standings on the streets of London, with an annual dispensation by the authorities in honour of the Carmen's heritage. In 1984 a special cart hiring board was created and presented by that year's Master: *The Carmen's Car*

This year, the cart is an 1898 Avondale cart built by Offord and Sons, established in 1791, who held a Royal warrant. This was a general carriage, typically used by governesses to carry children, due to its reputation for safety – an improvement on the gig or dog-cart. Today's cart is the property of the newly installed Master, but is offered for hire by practising Carmen, his two Wardens. The cart was acquired from late Carman Michael Banfield, and has been fully restored to pristine condition by Fairbourne Carriages of Kent. It was duly marked in Guildhall yard last year, powered by the pony, Edward.
